There are 18 members, one appointed by the governor, and the remainder appointed by state assemblymen and senators. There are 17 state judicial districts. Each district has two or more counties. The state representatives residing in those districts appoint the board members. Terms are for two years, and the counties in each district rotate. The other county in the judicial district where I will be living is sitting for this term (and there was a vacancy, so the seat has just been filled again). I will begin attending meetings in September (the August meeting was last week), and at some point introduce myself to the local state representatives. I intend to apply for the Richland County seat, 5th Judicial District, for the term beginning Jan 1, 2021.

ACTION ALERT! <u>Bari Caine</u> - OLLI - We need more Conservative voices at OLLI (Osher <u>Lifelong Learning Institute</u> (like UNR for Seniors). They are located at 604 West Moana Lane - 2 blocks east of Lakeside Dr. Look them up at <u>olli.unr.edu</u>. Membership to take classes is only \$55/year, not-prorated, from Sept 1-Aug 31 of the following year.

ACTION ALERT! Vin Keenan - watchdog for all things Federal. It's the gun control issue again. Please call or email both the White House and Congressman Amodei to be wary of signing onto any gun control measure, as studies have shown Americans use guns in self-defense millions of times a year - most incidents are deterrent to violence, no one is shot and nothing is reported. <u>Gary Duarte</u> - of the non-profit US Nuclear Energy Foundation (USNEF) had some info about SNRs (small nuclear reactors). These small reactors are about 15' wide and 75' tall and can power 40,000-60,000 homes, with 98% efficiency without refueling.

There is a huge misconception about nuclear energy. Hydro-dams have been responsible for 2200 deaths in the US and 85,000 deaths in China. Nuclear energy has been responsible for many, many less: at Chernobyl, 50-60 were directly killed; at Fukushima, there were 0 deaths and maybe 100s in the next 40-50 years. So nuclear is safer, cleaner and more efficient than other means of energy.

<u>Jeff Church</u> - has three local issues to talk about today:

ACTION ALERT! 1) If you are a member of a church, please know that the Business Improvement District (BID) is going to be assessed a "fee" to downtown churches, which amounts to a tax that will benefit the homeless. Churches are not supposed to be taxed, so contact your Pastor and let him know about Jeff Church (www.renotaxrevolt.org) and Paul White at Quality of Life, (www.QOL-reno.org), both of whom are happy to come speak about the homeless situation and helping the mentally ill. There are ways to help and improve the homeless situation and mentally ill without taxing businesses and churches.

Even if your church is not downtown, it's a dangerous slippery slope, to start taxing the churches (or they'll confiscate the building). The Catholic Church and International Church of Christ are suing (case #CV19-01053) and others may need to file a complaint with the IRS or Atty Gen'l. The more complaints, the more likely this is to get attention.

ACTION ALERT! 2) Sept 19 Homeless Forum - details to follow on time and location, but no one for the conservative point of view has been invited to speak at this government-sponsored event. Please write to these 4 email addresses and ask why conservative voices are not allowed to be heard at a forum, sponsored by a government entity.

ACTION ALERT! 3) Annual car registration tax - NRS 371-043. Contact County Commissioners and let them know NO NEW TAXES. They are planning a "significant new revenue source...[their] goal is to fill County Chambers with 200+ people" [amenable to new taxes], potentially millions to be allocated to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. This means more \$\$ to the homeless situation. Again, there are ways to help the homeless situation, but throwing more money at it isn't the answer.

This meeting was scheduled for Sept 10, but has been taken off the agenda, but will return when we least expect it (maybe even Sept 10!). No one never knows what they really are planning. Send emails to the Commissioners and the person at Actionn.org and let them know NO NEW TAXES.
